

KPCA Membership Votes to Support Environmental Committee's Three Recommendations on Harrison's Pond

Environmental Committee Co-Chairs Steve Weber and Dorothy Chanin gave a full report on Harrison's Pond. Mr. Weber showed a video of how the water flowing around the old dam was eroding the embankment along St. Johnland Road. It was also explained that the San Remo Civic Association voted and approved the committee's three recommendations to the Town of Smithtown regarding the pond. Those recommendations were: 1. Request for the town to remove the old dam, since there is a large erosion problem from water flowing around it. The bridge on St. Johnland Road is in danger of collapsing in the near future if nothing is done. 2. Request that the town cleans out and maintain the storm drains in the area. 3. Request the town to clean out the debris in the creek as well as the catch basins that empty into it.

Any discussion about restoring the pond would only take place after our three recommendations have been taken care of.

KPCA members voted and approved the three recommendations.
